Ist to VIII (without aid) w.e.f. academic session
1986-87 for a day school (Single shift).

Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject
cited above, I am directed to grant recognition to your
school from class Ist to VIII (without aid) w.e.f. 1986-87
subject to the fulfilment of the following terms & conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act & Rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed and preference shall be given to the students of Sindhora Kalan.
3. That the school shall appoint full time qualified and eligible staff for all classes of the school as per the present norms of the Department.
4. That the school shall equip the Science Lab. as per the norms of the Department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students.
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per students may be added and facilities of reading room may also be provided immediately. More (approved standard) books worth Rs.10,000/- may be purchased immediately.
6. That adequate sports materials worth Rs.3000/- shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately.
7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Sec.10(1) of Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973.
8. That the enrolment in each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq.ft. per student for the available floor area of the class-room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in each class. Number of existing sections should not be exceeded the number of class-rooms of proper size in the school.

9. That the school shall not run any pre-primary and unrecognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place. Nursery class be removed from the premises of the school, if any. No Branch of this school shall be run under the banner of the recognised school.
10. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified & over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
11. That service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
12. That all the facilities prescribed under Rule 50 and 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students. Provision of Rules 6,7 and 9 be strictly observed.
13. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the local body within a month.
14. That management of the school shall create a reserve fund of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousands only) in a joint account in the name of the Director of Education and the Manager of the school in any scheduled bank within a month.
15. That the facilities and benefits of the aided school may not be utilised for the purpose of unaided school and a separate entrance gate may be provided for both the schools so that character of aided school and Public school which have been functioning from the aided school complex may not be mixed up.
16. That the violation of any instruction/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the Department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school. That class ~~XI~~ shall not be added to the school without the prior permission of the Director of Education, Delhi.
17. That no development fee shall be charged from the students.
18. That a report about the fulfilment of the above conditions giving the extent to which each condition is fulfilled shall be sent to the Education Officer every six month.

w.e.f. academic session 1987-88(Without-aid).

Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Delhi, for the upgradation of the existing Middle School to Secondary level with effect from 1987-88 session, subject to the fulfilment of the following terms & conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act and Rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
3. That the school will meet the additional liability of secondary classes.
4. That the school shall establish and equip all the science Labs. The management shall purchase science material/equipments worth Rs. 10,000 (Ten thousand) immediately as per the norms of the Department/C.D.S.E. ^{USA and}
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student may be added.
6. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately.
7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of section 10(i) of the Delhi School Education Act and Rules, 1973, and payment shall be made through crossed cheques.
8. That the enrolment of each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq.ft. per student for the available floor area of the class-room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education in each class. Number of sections should not exceed the number of existing class-rooms of proper size in the school and each class-room, science lab. and library rooms may be fitted with proper electrical appliances.
9. That the school shall not run any un-recognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at once place at the above address only. Nursery classes be removed from the premises of the school immediately. That the school shall obtain the fresh Health Certificate from the M.C.D.

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10. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
11. That the service contract between the Management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
12. That all the facilities prescribed under rule 50 & 51 of the RER, 1973, shall be made available to the students.
13. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to the trs. and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the Local Body within a month.
14. That class XI shall not be opened in the school unless adequate building is constructed and necessary permission is obtained from the Director of Edn., Delhi.
15. That the Management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten Thousand) only in the name of the Director of Education & The Manager of the school.
16. That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.
17. That the school society shall obtain land from the D.D.A. and will construct the building as per the specifications & the department within a period of three years.
18. That the school shall shift its all classes from Ist to X to the new site and after the construction of a suitable building therein, with the prior approval of the Director of Education, Delhi. The present school will be closed there-
after forthwith.

10. Managing committee of school shall not increase fee during academic session without prior approval of Director of Education which is mandatory under sub-section (3) of section 17 of the DSEA 73.

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11. That all the conditions of rule 50 of DSEA & R 1973 shall be fulfilled and facilities under rule 51 of DSEA & R 1973 shall be made available to the students.
12. That proof to the effect that qualified staff has been appointed as per R.R.s be provided for verification of E.O.
13. That the arrangement for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as the teachers and sanitary arrangement as per norms be made in the school.
14. That the school shall comply with the norms of the C.B.S.E. for affiliation for examination purposes.
15. Medical facilities, leave, L.T.C., bonus, Teaching allowance, C.P.F. and other related facilities be provided to the staff as per Govt. norms.
16. Provident fund register will be maintained and cash book completed and shown to the E.O. of Zone concerned for verification from time to time.
17. That the violation of any rules and regulations of DSEA & R 1973 and instructions of the deptt. shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.
18. That the report about the fulfilment of above conditions shall be sent to the E.O. concerned within six months.
19. That the school shall file returns as specified under rule 180 of DSER, 1973 by the date.
20. That the school shall maintain high academic standards.
